1.4 Shared Vision and Purpose

2. OBJECTIVES OF COLLABORATION

This MOU establishes a framework for collaboration between the College and HHHF (through JAN AI) to achieve the following objectives:

- **Build Local Capacity:** Develop technical capabilities among students, youth, and community members to create and deploy AI solutions for local challenges.
- **Drive Innovation:** Foster research, innovation, and entrepreneurship in AI-driven solutions for rural / urban development.
- **Create Social Impact:** Develop and implement technology interventions that measurably improve livelihoods, governance, and economic opportunities.
- **Advance Knowledge:** Conduct collaborative research to understand rural / urban contexts, document impact, and contribute to the field of inclusive AI.
- **Scale Solutions:** Create replicable models and frameworks that can be scaled across regions and communities.

4.2 Head Held High Foundation (through JAN AI) shall:

- Provide AI training content, resources, and technical support for capacity-building programs
- Facilitate access to grassroots networks, rural/urban communities, and field implementation opportunities
- Offer mentorship and guidance from AI experts, industry professionals, and social entrepreneurs.
- Coordinate with corporate partners, government agencies, and funding organisations
- Manage logistics and coordination for community events, summits, and external engagements
- Designate a programme manager as the primary point of contact for this collaboration

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

This MOU establishes a framework for collaboration and does not create financial obligations for either party.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both parties agree to maintain strict confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information shared during the course of the collaboration. Disclosure of such information shall not occur unless required by applicable law or with prior written consent of the disclosing party.

7. DATA PROTECTION AND ETHICS

Both parties commit to upholding the highest standards of ethical conduct and data protection in all collaborative activities. Specifically, both parties shall:

- Obtain free, prior, and informed consent from all participants and beneficiaries
- Protect personal data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, including the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023
- Ensure ethical conduct in all research and community engagements
- Prioritise community welfare, dignity, and agency in all technology interventions
- Adhere to responsible and inclusive AI principles in the development and deployment of AI solutions

8. TERM AND TERMINATION

8.1 Duration

This MOU shall remain valid for a period of One year from the date of signing, unless extended or terminated earlier as provided herein.

8.2 Renewal

The MOU may be renewed or extended for additional periods upon mutual written agreement of both parties, to be negotiated at least Thirty (30) days before expiration.

8.3 Termination

Either party may terminate this MOU by providing thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the other party. Termination shall not affect any ongoing activities or commitments already in progress, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.

8.4 Effect of Termination

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The parties agree to collaborate on the following areas:

3.1 AI Awareness and Capacity Building

- Conduct workshops, bootcamps, and training sessions on AI tools, prompt engineering, and practical applications
- Create train-the-trainer programs to build local capacity for sustained AI education

3.2 JAN AI Internship Program

- Establish a structured internship program enabling students to work on real-world AI projects in rural / urban communities
- Connect students with grassroots organisations, government departments, and rural enterprises for hands-on experience
- Provide mentorship, project guidance, and impact assessment frameworks for student interns
- Collaborate with corporate partners and government bodies to expand internship opportunities and funding

3.3 Research and Innovation

- Conduct collaborative research on community needs assessment, barriers to AI adoption, impact evaluation, ethical governance frameworks, and development of vernacular AI models
- Co-author research papers, case studies, and reports documenting learnings and best practices
- Pursue joint funding opportunities from government, foundations, and research institutions

3.4 JAN AI Community Events and Summits

- Organise JAN AI Community Events including workshops, demo days, and pre-summits to showcase student projects and community innovations
- Facilitate College participation as Academic Partner in the India AI Impact Summit and JAN AI Pavilion
- Provide a platform for students and faculty to present research findings and innovations
- Enable networking with technology leaders, policymakers, investors, and grassroots practitioners

3.5 Youth Engagement and Governance

- Engage with district administrations and government bodies to ensure youth voices are represented in local governance and policy-making
- Conduct policy dialogues and advocacy to strengthen youth-centric governance models and AI-inclusive development policies
- Create platforms for students to interact with policymakers and contribute to evidence-based policy recommendations

3.6 Branding and Promotion

Both parties shall not use each other's logos, names, and branding for promotional activities related to collaborative programs, events, and initiatives without prior written approval.

4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 The College shall:

- Provide access to institutional infrastructure, facilities, and resources as mutually agreed
- Facilitate student and faculty participation in JAN AI programs and activities
- Promote JAN AI programs through institutional communication channels
- Designate a faculty coordinator as the primary point of contact for this collaboration

12. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Non-Binding Nature

This MOU represents a statement of mutual intent and good faith. It does not create legally binding obligations on either party, except as specifically provided under the Confidentiality (Clause 6).
